## Children will:

- **Cross my legs**
- **Good looking**
- **Good listening to my friends and teachers**
- **Good thinking**
- **Share my thoughts and ideas**
- **Respect my friends' learning**

## Adults, as duty bearers will:

- Get down to children's level
- Encourage children to sit in a circle
- Gain eye contact with children
- Use children's names individually
- Use visual cues to remind children of the rules at group time
- Listen to children
- Praise good looking, listening, thinking and talking

## Parents and carers, as duty bearers, can:

- Listen to children
- Involve children in conversations
- Praise good listening and good talking
