

Charter for Leadership Roles





Article 12

We have the right to be listened to, and taken seriously.

Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously.

Children will:

Leader role

- o Help to take our register
- o Lead our line
- o Give out our lunch bags
- Water our plants

Helper

- o Feed the fish and clean out our fish tank
- Put away resources to make sure our classrooms are tidy
- o Help Hana to clean our tables & sweep the lunch room
- o Pick up litter from our garden and put it in the bin

Eco Warrior

- o Compost fruit waste from snack time
- o Recycle plastic and paper after lunch
- Compost our food waste after lunch
- o Help Hana to put our food waste in the wormery
- o Turn the lights off in the lunch room after lunch

Rights Champion

- Talk to the Rights Respecting Steering Group about what our friends like and don't like at nursery
- o Carry out safety checks with Sarah to make sure our garden is safe
- o Remind our friends about our rights

Adults, as duty, bearers will:

- Choose children to carry out Leadership roles at the first group time session each week
- Make sure children take turns to carry out the different leadership roles (using a tick list)
- Support children in carrying out the roles

Parents and carers, as duty bearers, can:

• Give children the responsibility of helping with small tasks such as laying the table, putting the shopping away etc.
