Challenge your child to put their favourite toy in a range of different places around the room using this

vocabulary:

'Under', 'on top', 'behind'.

Can your child respond to instructions with two parts?

EG: Run to the door, then touch your toes.

Ask your child to think of something they are really good at. Can they describe it to you?

Physical Development

Set your child a challenge of moving in as many different ways as they can when out and about.

Can they slither, shuffle, roll, crawl, walk, run, jump, skip, slide and hop?

Can your child use tools at home eg a knife (with supervision) to cut fruit or scissors to cut along a straight or curved line?

Literacy

Each week your child will bring home a library book. Please share the story with your child. You can upload an observation to Tapestry, adding comments that your child has made about the story.

Can your child retell the story in the correct order?

Have a go at writing their name every day.

Mathematics

This half term one of our Core Rhymes is 1,2,3,4,5, Once I caught a fish alive.'

Sing the rhyme with your child. Can they count out ten fish on their fingers?

Can they find the numbers 1-10 around your home or outside eg on your phone or on the remote control, on the bus or on a front door? Extend them with numbers to 30

Understanding the World

Go on an Autumn stroll through the park with your child. Collect all the signs of Autumn that you find eg pine cones, conkers or different coloured leaves.

Talk with your child about what they notice. Can they tell you how they look and feel?

Do they know what each of the natural objects are?

Expressive Arts and Design

Ask your child to draw a picture of their whole family. We have a family board at nursery where we are displaying your family photos and would love to add to them.

Can your child talk to you about the similarities and differences between family members?

Upload to Tapestry and we can then add it to our boards.
