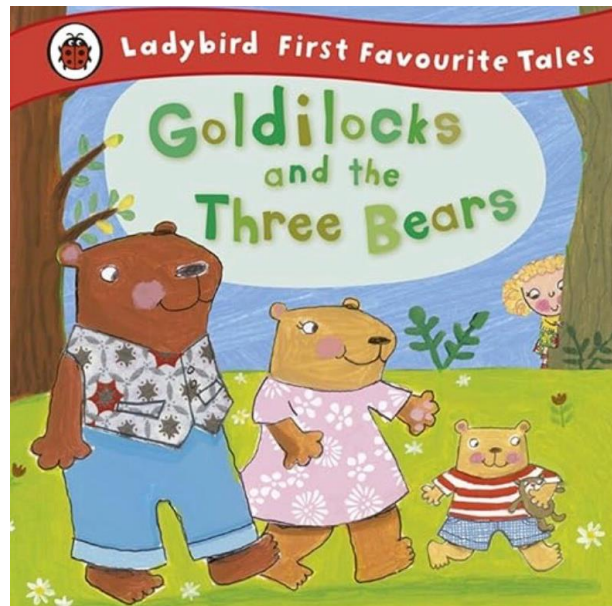


Home Learning Goldilocks and the Three Bears



Our current core book is Goldilocks and the three bears. We are learning lots of new vocabulary such as Goldilocks, house, bears, big, small, medium, middle-sized, tiny, porridge. Maybe your child can tell you about the new vocabulary we are learning such as describing a 'big' toy and a 'small' toy.

Below are some activities you may wish to try at home with your child:

- share the story of Goldilocks. What did Goldilocks do in the bears' house? What happened when the bears came home? Maybe you could try using different voices for each character. If you don't have access to a copy of the book you could listen to it read aloud on the link below.
