#### **Communication and Language**

Look at some of your child's baby photographs. Talk about them with your child including the things they used to do when they were a baby, what they liked/didn't like, what made them laugh and cry, where you used to take them.

Encourage your child to share what they think about themselves as a baby. This will help your child to develop conversational skills and increase their use of simple sentences. Each half term we will be sending out activities and ideas for you to do at home to support your child's learning at nursery. They will include all seven areas of learning from the EYFS curriculum. Please complete the activities with your child and then upload your photos and comments on to our Tapestry app.

#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Take your child to a mirror. Make different emotion faces (happy, sad, scared, angry) in the mirror and tell your child the emotion face you are making. After each face you make, ask your child to copy it.

It's important for your child to learn to express how they are feeling.

## **Physical Development**

Whilst at home, encourage your child to travel around in different ways. They could crawl under the bed, climb over the chair, jump around the table.

Can you come up with some new ways to travel around each piece of equipment?

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#### Literacy

Provide your child with paint, felt pens, chalk or crayons. Encourage your child to draw whatever they want. As they draw, talk about what they are drawing. You can also talk about other things that they can add to their drawing

### Mathematics

Go on a shape hunt around the house and garden. Encourage your child to look for simple shapes as they go around the house. You could identify a rectangle/square in a picture on the wall or a photograph; a circle in a plate or even a triangle in a folded napkin.

## **Understanding the World**

Go outside in the garden and look at all the things that are now growing . Can you describe the flowers, and leaves that you can see?

Talk about how plants need water and sunshine to grow. What would happen if they didn't get any water?

# **Expressive Arts and Design**

Practise singing some well-known Nursery rhymes and songs together. There's always a list on our latest Newsletter. Does your child know all of the words?
